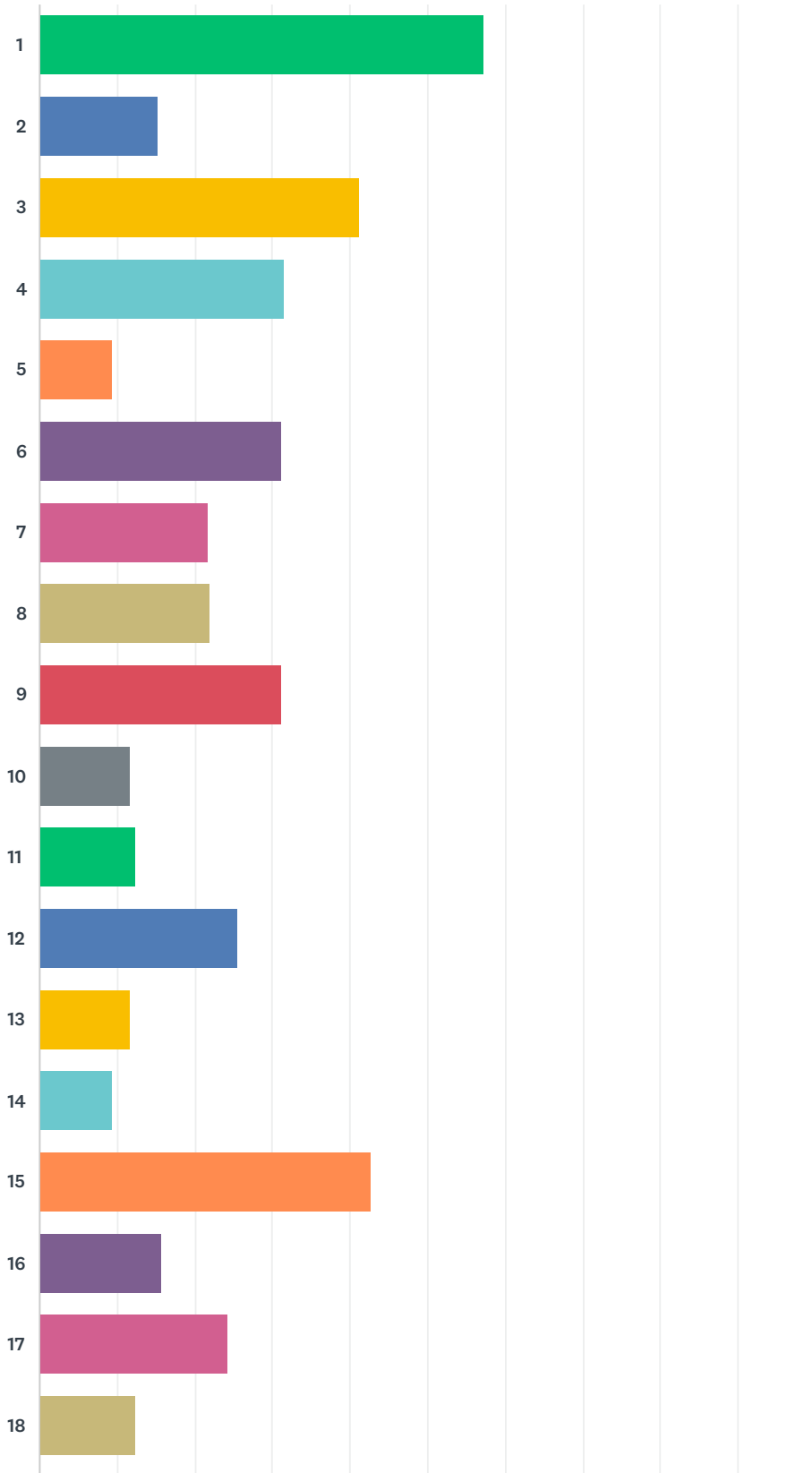
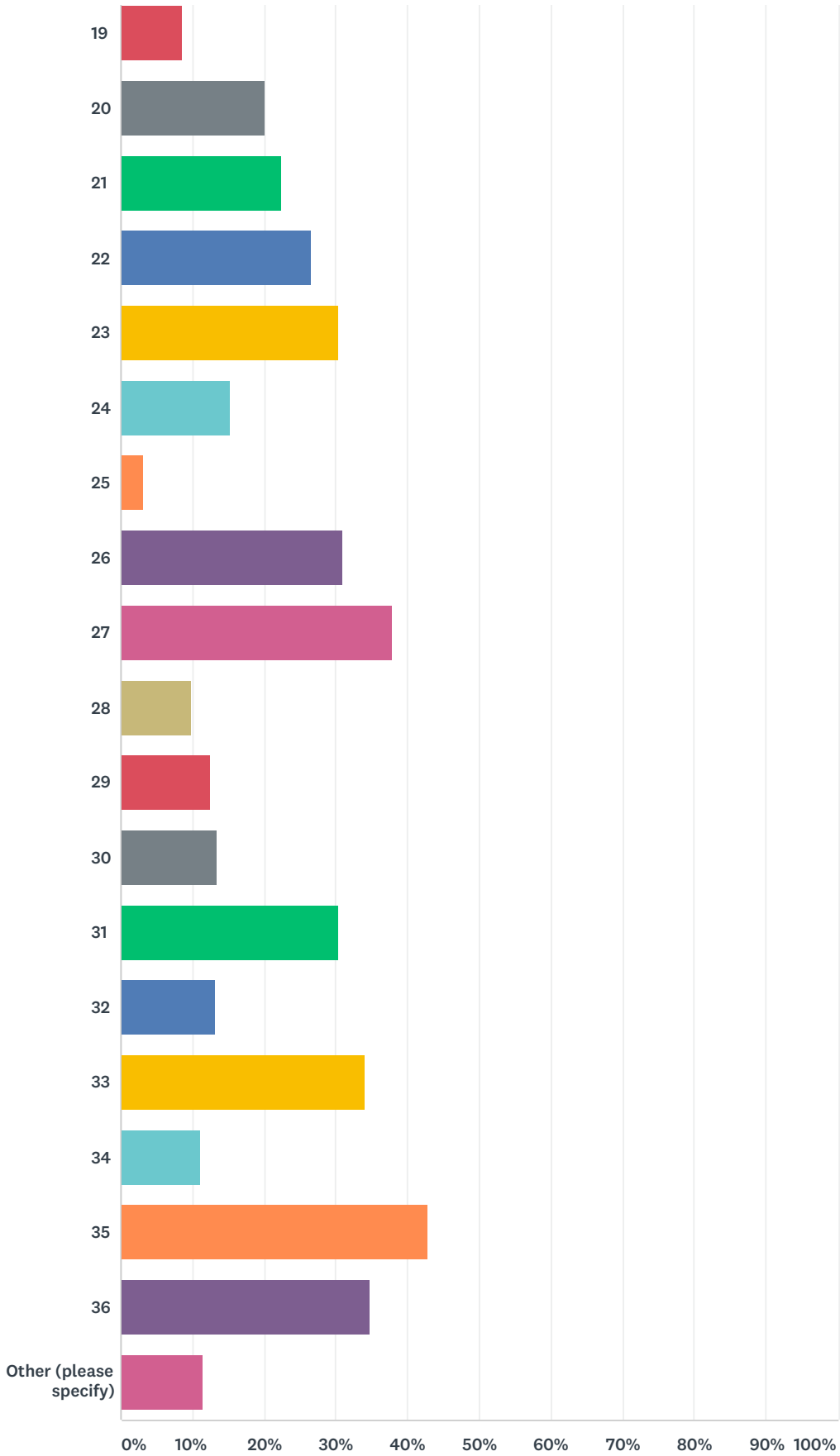


Q1 Please look at the images above and choose up to 10 design elements that you would like to see in the new park.

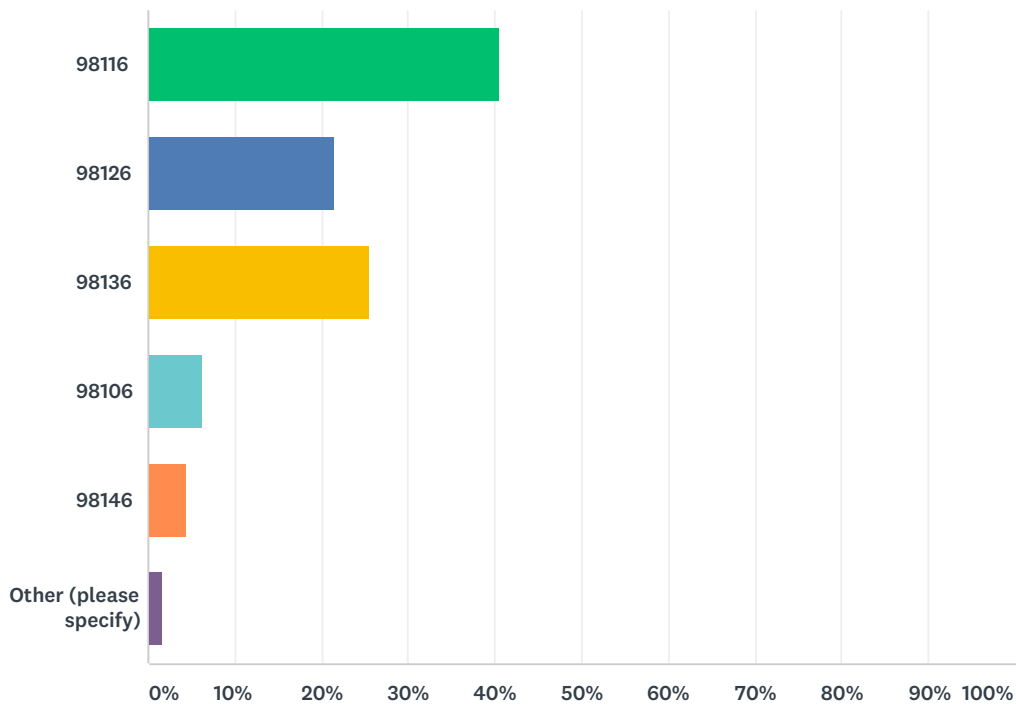
