

Queen Anne Ave Protected Bike Lane Extension

AUGUST 2023

As part of the North Downtown Mobility Action Plan programmatic improvements, we will install a new protected bicycle lane on Queen Anne Ave N. The lane will connect existing biking facilities on Queen Anne Ave N from Mercer St to bike lanes on Roy St. Once complete, the lane will separate modes of transportation, provide protection for people riding bikes of all ages and abilities, and preserve access to businesses.

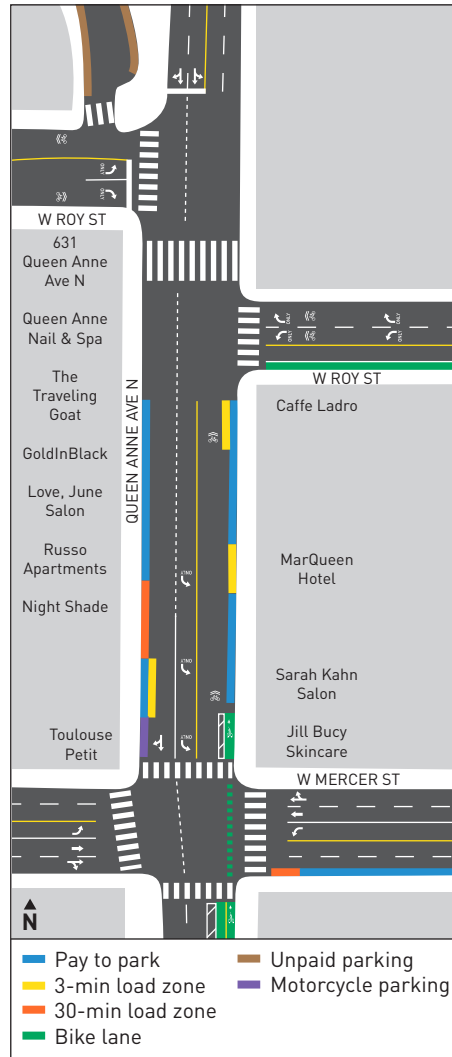
Proposed changes on this block include:

- New 2-way protected bicycle lanes
- East side parking adjustments that include an additional load zone
- Conversion of two-way street to one-way SB only
- Updated turning movements with pavement markings, signage, and signal changes at nearby intersections

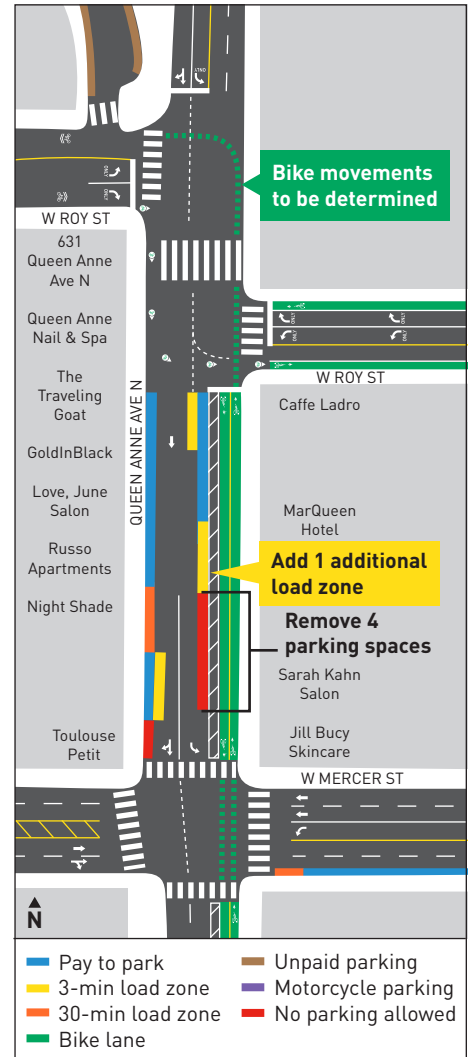
This project complements transportation and safety enhancements in the area made around the Climate Pledge Arena and Uptown neighborhood.

Construction is expected to take place in 2024.

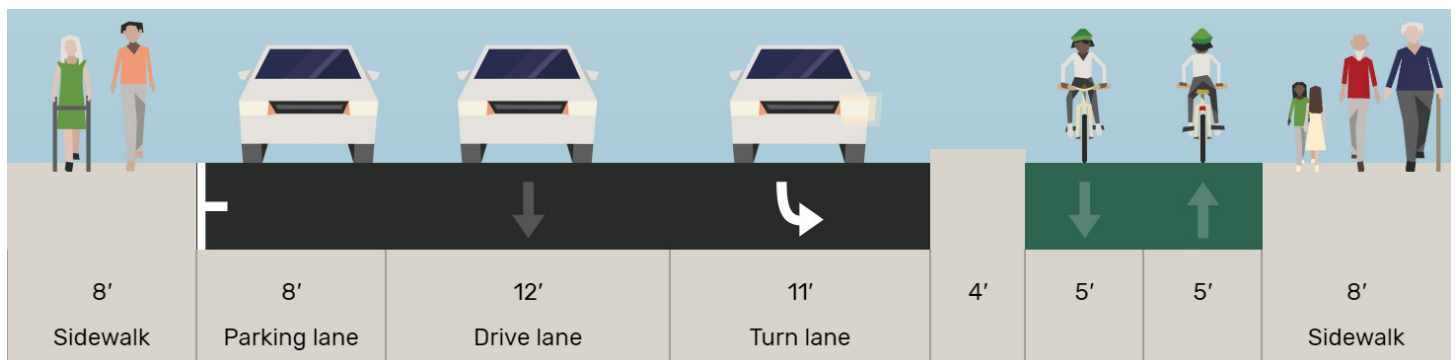
